The federal government is reviewing our Mass Casualty Ventilation for Non-respiratory Personnel training site. They might use it to train nurses and other people that would act as Respiratory extenders. Wisconsin was one of the states that had better than 90% of hospitals responding to the National Ventilator Survey. The results were to be discussed in San Antonio, but there were delays getting the data to the states which had to be done first.
